

and those who want to become one. Africa is vastness, independence, adventure, enjoyment of the senses, Africa is finding one's own 'self'. But what is Botswana? Botswana shows us the Africa we imagine – vast savannahs, landscapes criss-crossed by rivers, camel thorn trees where elephants shake the ripe fruit from the trees, with a pride of lions lying under the next one, seeking shade from the burning sun. And we? We are right in the middle of the world's largest transboundary national park, right in the middle of the KAZA project, right in the middle of the Okavango Delta World Heritage Site. In the KAZA, huge wildlife sanctuaries in Angola, Botswana, Namibia, Zambia and Zimbabwe have been connected by migratory corridors, along which wild animals migrate through the savannahs on historical migratory routes, as they have done for centuries, without being stopped by national borders.

It is precisely to these areas that we are drawn. We have put together fifteen safari tours for you in 2025 that will showcase the uniqueness of Botswana.

We don't spend our time on asphalt roads that run for hundreds of kilometres around the parks; instead, we are drawn directly into the wilderness, directly into the parks. We spend the night with our guests in a private luxury tented camp, built by our team directly in the national park or in a private concession. No fence separates us from nature, the sounds of the savannah surround us, and in the background, the king of the savannah roars while you slumber in your beds. Of course, you will be provided with full service. On our safaris,

we offer full board plus, and all available drinks are included! It's pure adventure, and it's not much different from what the first adventurers in this area experienced at the end of the 19th century. An elephant could wander through camp at any time.

When is the best time to travel? The simple answer is always. Every season has its special aspects.

We Europeans are put off by the rainy season, but in Botswana it only means short, heavy showers on 8 to 10 days a month. On the other hand, nature plays with the most vibrant shades of green and clear air, making for fantastic photos. The rainy season begins in November and ends in March. Temperatures during the rainy season are between 30 and 35 °C during the day and between 18 and 23 °C at night. The rest of the time is dry season, when it hardly rains. During the day, temperatures range from 25 to 30 °C, at night from 10 to 15 °C, in October above 20 °C. As the dry season progresses, nature turns increasingly yellow, and the animals are drawn to the remaining waterholes, making it easier to get them on camera. But the photographer has to make do with fewer colours.

Oh yes, the best photos are taken in the hour after sunrise and before sunset – see for yourself and simply join us on one of our dreamlike tours!

We have combined the Luxury Tented Safari with lodges in Maun and Victoria Falls, because this World Heritage Site, just like the Okavango Delta, should not be missing from our tour.








